Welcome back! I hope everyone had a wonderful, restful break and new year celebration.

In class this week, we began Math Unit 6. This unit covers geometry concepts. Primarily, students should be able to differentiate between 2-dimensional and 3-dimensional shapes (flat vs. those that "stick out"). They should also be able to use terms like line, line segment, ray, parallel, and intersecting correctly, as well as be able

to identify right angles.

In reading, we began the story Your Dad Was Just Like You and practiced identifying and making generalizations. At this stage, the students are mainly looking for the clue words associated with generalizations (always, never, all, everybody, nobody, etc.).

In social studies, we reviewed information from before the break and made a timeline to help students keep historical events in

order. We also began talking about the French and Indian War.

In science, students practiced manipulating shadows and identifying objects as transparent, translucent, and opaque. We're almost ready to move on to sound!

Composition time has us working on organization. We've been working on keeping similar details together.


