

This Week in Class



In science this week, we covered all of the windows in our classroom to get it as dark as we could so we could practice reflecting light with mirrors. We identified the source of the light, the path of the light, and the reflection. We also learned about objects that are opaque, translucent, and transparent.

In social studies, we practiced naming the continents and oceans everyday. We'll have a quiz labeling them next Wednesday. In Michigan studies, we learned about some of the state symbols. Thanks go out to Ian for bringing in an abandoned nest used by our state bird, the robin.

Math was very busy this week. We continued working with number grids and practiced identifying place value. Also, we worked on skip counting by 10s, 100s, and 1,000s.

In reading, we read <u>Goldilocks</u> from our textbook. The skill lesson for this story was

drawing conclusions. We also began the next story, "Anthony Reynoso," and discussed how authors set a purpose for writing.

In composition this week, the students practiced editing paragraphs and choosing good ideas for writings. They planned a paragraph using a web, and wrote a letter to a first grader in Mrs. Burch's class. We will send those letters to her as soon as the final copies are finished.
